We Really Love Our Volunteers

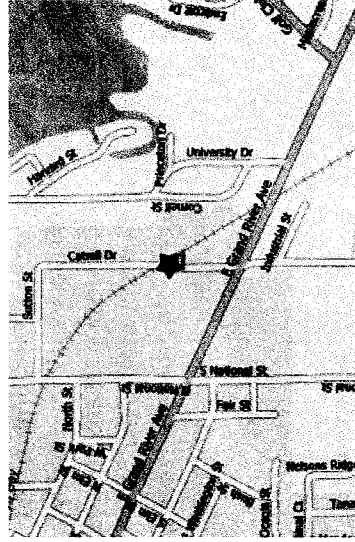

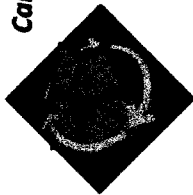
Newspaper

Newspaper is collected separately from other types of paper and includes the Sunday inserts. Also includes phone books, TV guides, or other magazines printed on newsprint paper.



Cardboard/Brown Paper Bags/ Box board

Please flatten and remove any inner linings



Mixed Paper

Most types of paper are included in this category. Some of the most common examples would be magazines, junk mail, copy paper, construction paper, paperboard, envelopes, file folders, shredded paper, and books. Staples are fine however all other metal clips, etc. need to be removed.



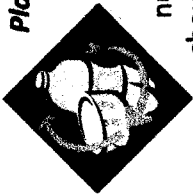
Shoes

We accept wearable shoes and boots. International Trading Solution sends our shoes to other countries where they are used for walking long distances and to work.

We cannot accept high heeled shoes, flip flops, slippers or torn up shoes.

Plastic

All plastic is accepted together, with the recycling symbol marked clearly with the numbers #1 thru #7. Everything should be thoroughly rinsed.



Additionally, many rigid plastics without markings are also acceptable to recycle. Please call ahead or bring a sample of any questionable material.

Metal/Aluminum

We will sort the metal for you. We accept any items that is 85% metal. This also includes appliances. There is a \$10 Freon removal fee for any appliance that contains Freon.



Glass

We accept clear, brown, and green glass, all thoroughly rinsed clean. Please remove any plastic or metal lids. We cannot accept any mirrors, leaded, window, auto, drinking glasses or Pyrex glass.



Styrofoam

We collect polystyrene foam in the form of meat trays, cups, and clam shells. Please clean thoroughly. We cannot collect foam peanuts, but most UPS shipping outlets will accept these.

Electronics

We accept a wide variety of electronics, for free from our membership, including computer towers, printers, DVD, CD, and VCR players, stereo equipment, radios, microwaves, etc. We have fees for televisions and monitors ranging from \$10 to \$45 each due to the heavy lead and often hazardous materials found there.

Batteries

In conjunction with Livingston County, we can collect all sizes of household batteries, lithium, or hearing aid batteries.

Vinyl Siding

We take vinyl siding of all colors. Please cut into 10 foot lengths.

Latex Paint

We accept Latex paint for a \$2/fee per containers. This includes quart, gallon, and 5 gallon sized containers.

Please consider becoming a member. Yearly dues are \$30 for a family/\$25 for a senior household (62 or older) or use the site periodically for \$3 a visit.
