## JUNK, INOPERABLE, UNPLATED VEHICLE ORDINANCE

\*Unadilla Township Ordinance Section 4.07: Use of yard spaces and other open areas for storage

The following provisions shall apply:

(A) No front or other yard shall be used for the storage of automobiles or any other materials or equipment; provided that in residential areas automobiles with a current license and in operating condition may be parked on an approved service driveway, extending from the street directly to a side yard or a garage. No machinery, equipment, vehicles, lumber piles, crates, boxes, building blocks, or other materials either discarded, unsightly, or showing evidence of a need for repairs, and with or without current license, shall be stored, parked, abandoned or junked in any open area that is visible from the street, public place or adjoining residential property. If such use of land occurs, it shall be declared a nuisance, and in violation of the Ordinance.

Article XVIII: Enforcement and penalties, fees

Section 17.00 Noncompliance with Ordinance

Any person, firm or corporation which violates, neglects or refuses to comply with any provision of this ordinance shall be fined, upon conviction thereof, not more than \$500 together with the cost of prosecution or shall be punished by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days for each such offense or may be both fined and imprisoned at the discretion of the Court. Each day during which a violation continues shall be deemed a Separate offense. The imposition of any sentence shall not exempt any Offender from compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Penalty: 93-day misdemeanor and/or up to a \$500
