May 13, 2021

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge to flag.

Present: Walker, Topping, Weiland, Cowan, Cox. Absent: None.

Motion Walker support Weiland to approve the agenda. Carried.

Motion Walker support Cowan to approve the March 11, 2021 minutes. Carried.

Motion Walker support Cox to approve payment of bills as presented. Carried.

Call to Public: Mr. & Mrs. Foster complaint presentation about a dumpster business in their residential area. Other neighbors also present. Board is in agreement with residents and it is turned over to attorney for action. Discussion on contacting EGLE also because of the type of business operating. Watson Show Cause: Not present.

Doug Helzerman our Livingston County Commissioner presented fiber broadband options being discussed at the county. Unadilla is very interested in getting internet for our residents and hope to spend our infrastructure funds toward that goal.

Police Report by Chief Russell, new cameras are installed via grant. They held their department dinner and handed out awards for the year. They have applied for a grant and were awarded \$2500 towards Chief training in September. The new car has been ordered.

Fire Report by Chief Hause, she reports 4 students passed the academy, 1 starting the academy and 1 MFR classes. July 4<sup>th</sup> plans coming along, still uncertain about chicken bbq. Chief requests we put flyer in tax bills informing about upcoming events.
